# AFTER SCHOOL BASKETBALL RULES

### GENERAL RULES

1. One time out allowed per half.
2. Five second rule applies in the key.
3. \$18.00 per team per game - \$38.00 per team registration – including team insurance.
4. \$2.00 door charge for all players and spectators (over the age of 12years). 12 & Under Spectators NO CHARGE
5. COACHES (must be K&MDBA Members) that are nominated on the Entry form will be admitted free of charge (tick sheet will be at the door each week). ONLY COACHES PRINTED ON THE TICK SHEET are permitted to bring in a basketball for team warm-up.

### LOCAL RULES:

1. Three point rule does not apply to Primary Competition. All field shots are worth 2 points.
2. All teams to supply a competent scorer for each game; this is to protect yourselves against score sheet discrepancies.
3. One warm up basketball per team to be brought into the stadium. Only game ball supplied. The warm-up ball is to be under the control of the coach at all times.
4. Any team that gives three successive walkovers is dropped from the competition.
5. Teams that require a cancelled game, for a school camp or activity, must notify the convenor by the following:  
Term 1 – By the start of the new season, and for Terms 2/3/4 – By the beginning of that term.  
Teams that have notified by these times will receive two (2) premiership points for that game. For any cancelled games outside of these times, three (3) points will be awarded to the non-cancelling team, zero (0) points awarded to cancelling team.
6. Players must play one third of the available games (excluding byes) to qualify for the finals.
7. ELIGIBILITY: Players registered and playing A grade cannot play in C grade or below regardless of the age group. Players cannot play more than one game per round in the same age group – if their team has a bye they can fill in. They must fill in details on back of scoresheet. Players who play more than one third of the season in a higher grade of the same age group cannot return to a lower grade in the same age group.
8. Girls may not play in boys' teams without prior permission from the Convenor (David Lawson) via the school representative.
9. Penalty of 2 points per player for incorrect uniform.
10. Teams must play man-to-man defense during the first half of this game. If a zone defense is set up, one warning will be given by the referee; thereafter a technical foul will be imposed.
11. Team sheet to be paid before match commences. Last team to pay takes score sheet to bench.
12. The school representative must be informed of any players being added to a team after re-grading and the school representative must notify the convenor if such an addition changes the strength of the team. The inclusion of a high standard player (e.g.: Kilsyth Cobra, Knox Raider or A Grade club competitor) may cause a team to be re-graded.
13. All new players must complete a mauve membership application form. These can be found in the notice racks at both Kilsyth and Lilydale. Membership fee \$1.10. This can be paid to the Kiosk at Kilsyth or Lilydale Stadium.
14. Walkover time 8 minutes, one point per minute for lateness.
15. The first-named team on the scoresheet is to mop the court at half-time.
16. Any coach, who continually harasses the referees, risks the expulsion of his team. Our aim is to promote both the game of basketball and sportsmanship. Remember, the referees are learning too.

If you have any problems at the game which the Referees' Supervisor cannot solve, then speak to your school Representative who will contact David Lawson, the After-school Competition Convenor.
