SENIOR COMPETITION INFORMATION SHEET -

1. **REGISTRATION** - Players registrations have been taken from your entry form. New players (or players who did not complete all details on the entry form) must write name, address, phone number, date of birth and signature on the form on the back of the scoresheet at their first game.

All players must be members of Kilsyth & Mountain District Basketball Association. To become a member players are required to fill out a mauve membership form. Membership is \$2.20. Forms are available from kiosk at Kilsyth and Lilydale Stadiums. *The mauve form is required to be completed **once only, whilst you continue to play in the competition*** (Not every season).

Teams using unregistered players will **LOSE premiership points for that game.**

2. **CHARGES** - At Kilsyth and Lilydale Stadiums - \$39.00 per team per game. (\$41.00 for 50minute games). Includes GST. Entry to the stadium is \$2.00 for players & spectators 12 years & over.
3. **NOTICEBOARDS** - Please watch the noticeboard for ladders, unregistered players, changes to fixtures, and your position on the final ladder. Teams are not contacted individually.
4. **SCORESHEETS** - Please write players' number next to names on the scoresheet. **Please nominate court captain by placing "C" beside the captains name.**
5. **SCORERS** - Both teams must provide a competent scorer. If a team does not have a scorer there is a 10 point penalty.
6. **FINALS ELIGIBILITY** - Players who do not foul or score must sign the back of the scoresheet to have the game counted for finals' eligibility. To be eligible to play in finals a person must play 1/3 of the possible non-final games (excluding byes). Lists of eligible players are on the noticeboard six (6) weeks before the finals. Players injured **during the season** may have missed games counted if they lodge a doctor's certificate **before resuming playing**. Final ladders are displayed on the notice board. Please check your position as teams are not notified that they are in the finals.
7. **CLEARANCES** - No clearances are required in the Senior Competition if you change clubs between seasons, but once you have registered with a team a clearance is needed to transfer. No transfers are allowed after the 6th (sixth) round of a season.

8. **WALKOVERS** - The fine for giving a walkover is \$55 (or \$25.00 if notified 24 hr. in advance). Players in attendance from both teams to sign the back of the scoresheet for finals' eligibility. If your team does not have sufficient players for a particular game ask any available person to play (even from another club), and note on the back of the scoresheet that you are using an illegal player. The game is played and forfeited but there is no fine.
9. **COURTS** - First-named team on the scoresheet must sweep the court at the nominated time.
10. **UNIFORMS** - Member clubs have priority when two teams have the same colour uniforms. If neither team is from a member club then priority is decided by the toss of a coin. Stadium singlets can be hired in the interim (\$6.50) for the game. **Shorts** - all team members must wear the same type of shorts (ie sports shorts or the longer style). Shorts are not to have pockets or tabs. Any bicycle shorts worn must be the same color as the uniform shorts or briefs and worn under the uniform shorts.

Teams are given three (3) weeks at the start of each season to arrange correct uniforms before penalties are imposed.
11. Any person swinging on or hanging from nets, rings or backboard supports will be sent from the stadium and reported to the Tribunal.
12. **SMOKING** is prohibited throughout the stadium, including the foyer.
13. **BY-LAWS** are displayed on the covered noticeboard
14. **INSURANCE** - If an injury occurs during the game an insurance claim can be made. A claim form is available from the door keeper or the stadium office.
The Insurance does not cover all your injury costs. Insurance information sheets are available from the door keeper or the stadium office.
15. **FIRST AID** - Teams are asked to bring their own first aid kit. Ice is available from the kiosks at Kilsyth and Lilydale.
16. **BLOOD RULE** – If any player is bleeding from an injury he / she must leave the court to attend to the injury. The player (or the team if the player is too injured) is responsible for cleaning up any spilt blood. Gloves and disinfectant are available at the kiosk.
17. **PLAYER RESTRICTION:** Any player who is playing in an **ELITE LEAGUE** (as determined by the Match Committee) shall not be allowed to play any grade LOWER than A Reserve or Section 1, without prior approval from the Senior Committee..
18. **WARM UP TIME.**- There will be a two minute timed warm-up given , prior to the commencement of a game
